Bones, woman's clothing found

SALEM, Ark. — Fulton County officials have found what appear to be human bones in an area about two miles west of town.

The bones were found along with a woman's clothing, a watch and necklace, Sheriff Paul Martin said. The remains were to be turned over to the state crime lab, he said.

A hunter spotted the clothing Monday, the sheriff said. Officers were to search the area again Wednesday, he said.

Martin said the Nevada Police Department contacted him to see if the body might be that of Cheryl Kenney, 30. Kenney, a convenience store clerk, disappeared Feb. 27 after closing her store at 10 p.m. Her car was discovered the next morning outside the store, but Kenney has not been found.

But Captain John Eador of the Nevada Police Department said the jewelry found with the bones did not match the jewelry Kenney was reported to be wearing before her disappearance.

Martin said the bones also appeared to be several months old.
